

7/23/2008 - H.R. 3221, the American Housing Rescue and Foreclosure Prevention Act of 2008

Madam Speaker,

I rise today in support of H.R. 3221, the American Housing Rescue and Foreclosure Prevention Act of 2008. This amendment is very important for a number of reasons. First, this amendment aims to increase consumer spending in the mortgage market by creating a new standard deduction for state and local real estate taxes paid for those who do not itemize and it provides a refundable tax credit for first-time homebuyers.
